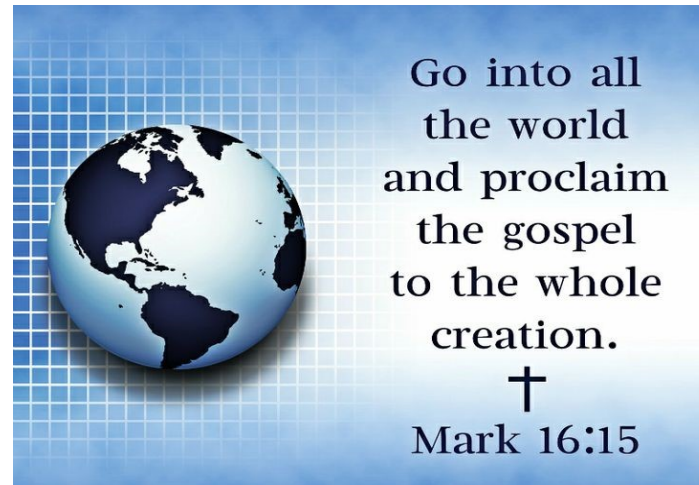

Wycliffe Bible Translators
Canada

D’Arcy Chapman is from the lower mainland and is in process of raising support to go to Europe to translate the Bible for a group of people who do not have the Bible in their own language.

“I’ve been interested in languages since I was a preteen. When my pastor informed me about Bible translation, it started me on a long journey through the wonderful world of language and linguistics. This journey included hearing about Wycliffe through other church family members, and doing a bachelor’s degree in linguistics at the University of Victoria, as well as a Master of Linguistics and Exegesis degree at Canada Institute of Linguistics. Now I seek to use my deep fascination with language to further God’s Kingdom through Old Testament translation in Eastern Europe as a linguist translator, so that more languages will have the whole counsel of God available.”

UPDATE: *The door to Russia is closed at this time. Please pray for D’Arcy as he is adjusting his language learning—*

“ I’m working towards (and actually really close to being able to start) working as part of the linguistic support team for SIL West Africa, where most of the work would be done from Langley, with languages in Côte D’Ivoire. The biggest prayer item right now, besides support-raising, is diligence in working on French.”
