The Persecuted Church

This (week), we pause to pray for five believers from southern Laos, who were imprisoned by local authorities on January 5th for refusing to give up their faith in Jesus.

These believers were summoned by the village chief to report to his office for interrogation. Upon arrival, local police officers were already waiting for them, and they were immediately apprehended and put into prison.

Other believers from this village have shared that the number of Christians there has grown significantly over the last year. It seems that local authorities view the growing church as a threat to their authority, and believers have been subjected to increased monitoring and have had to report regularly to the village chief's office for interrogation and asked to deny their faith.
