“Jesus Only Jesus” and review of previous songs



Mile One Mission was founded to reach the people of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador with the gospel of Jesus Christ through the planting of churches. Currently there are less than 1% of the population that attend any type of

evangelical church. They currently have two church plants in St. John’s: Downtown Community Church and Kilbride Community Church and one church plant in Happy Valley-Goose Bay—Northern Cross Community Church.

Please be in prayer for the following:

Northern Cross Community Church: John Lewis will be moving to Happy Valley-Goose Bay January 1st. Pray that he will be able to establish trust with the Indigenous communities and will have doors of opportunity opened for sharing the gospel. The area has a population of 9,000—45% are Anglo, 45% Indigenous and 10% Filipino.

Downtown Community Church: Pray for Adam (and Sabrina) Diamond as he shepherds this congregation. Pray for opportunities to reach into this broken community. There are approximately 10,000 people with no local evangelical church. Pray for stability as they have had to move their place of meeting as they were no longer able to meet in the Community Centre.

Kilbride Community Church: Pray for Matthew and Ruth Lahey as they have just found a permanent place for them to hold Bible Studies and services. Pray for continued growth as this small community has never had an evangelical presence before.
