Today's Lesson in Children's Church

Week 24: *God Gives Solomon Wisdom* • **1 Kings 2:1-4; 3:3-15**

Principle: We are unable to obey God without His help.

Ask Your Child: What did Solomon ask for, and how did God give it to him?

Apply: By asking God for the wisdom to obey Him.

This Week: As a family, read 1 Kings 2:1-4; 3:3-15
