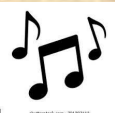

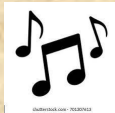

D'Arcy Chapman is currently in the Vancouver area working remotely with an SIL team in West Africa who are doing Bible translation for groups of people who do not have the Bible in their own language. Most of the work is in Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast).

### Prayer & Praise Items:

- Pray for continued diligence as work progresses in translation. Progress is often slow and tedious.
- Pray for unity among the team as D'Arcy works in conjunction with the team in Cote d'Ivoire. Pray clarity of communication as they work together. The team is also working on a dictionary which will enable readers to understand what they are reading. This is a large task.
