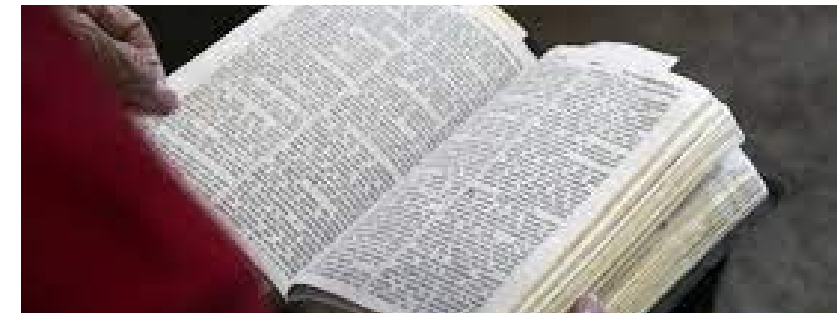

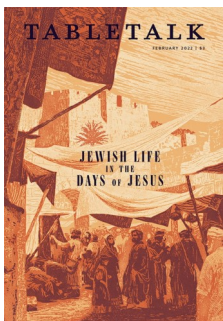


Table Talk Magazine
