

The Persecuted Church

"Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body."

Hebrews 13:3

"The group **Open Doors USA** figures that 360 million Christians last year (2021) lived in countries where persecution was "significant." Roughly 5,600 Christians were murdered, more than 6,000 were detained or imprisoned, and another 4,000-plus were kidnapped. In addition, more than 5,000 churches and other religious facilities were destroyed." *

Following are a few ways that we can pray for our brothers and sisters in other countries.

- 1. Pray that their ministry activities will remain undetected by authorities or others who wish to silence them.
- 2. Pray that they will rejoice even in the midst of suffering. (Acts 5:41)
- 3. Pray that they will be refreshed through the study of God's Word, and thus encouraged to grow strong in their faith.
