The Persecuted Church

"Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body."

Hebrews 13:3

"The group Open Doors USA figures that 360 million Christians last year (2021) lived in countries where persecution was "significant." Roughly 5,600 Christians were murdered, more than 6,000 were detained or imprisoned, and another 4,000plus were kidnapped. In addition, more than 5,000 churches and other religious facilities were destroyed." *
