Hello Prayer Team, May has been an exciting month where we saw God move in peoples’ lives!

First off, we saw 2 people come to Christ in the span of a week. One was a Muslim girl that I’ve mentioned before. We met her at our Young Adults Thanksgiving Dinner in April. Throughout the Fall she came to our campus prayer meetings, Young Adult studies and events, and Celeste and I had her over for supper. She’s been searching for Christ. In January she went back to her home country but plans to return in August. This past month we heard from her saying she has given her life to Christ and that He is everything she’s been searching for... praise God! Please continue to pray for her as it doesn’t seem like her family is approving. Also pray that she makes it safe back to Newfoundland as her home country can be dangerous for Christians.

Secondly, we have a Hindu friend that’s been regularly coming to church and a couple of us have been discipling him. It’s taken a lot of time and prayer and answering questions but I got word from him that he has come to faith in Christ. He too travelled back to his home country in April and his conversion happened then. We can’t wait to welcome both of these young believers back to Newfoundland when they return for the Fall semester at university. This time we welcome them back as brothers and sisters in Christ!

Mile One Mission

Mile One Mission was founded to reach the people of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador with the gospel of Jesus Christ through the planting of churches.

Currently there are less than 1% of the population that attend any type of evangelical church. They have three church plants in St. John’s: Downtown

Community Church, Route 10 Community Church, and the newest—Rabbittown Community Church and one church plant in Happy Valley-Goose Bay—Northern Cross Community Church.

Please be in prayer for the following:

Northern Cross Community Church: Pray for **John Lewis** as he seeks to establish trust with the Indigenous communities and that he will have doors of opportunity opened for sharing the gospel. The area has a population of 9,000—45% are Anglo, 45% Indigenous and 10% Filipino.

Downtown Community Church: Pray for **Adam and Sabrina Diamond** as he shepherds this congregation. Pray for opportunities to reach into this broken community. There are approximately 10,000 people with no local evangelical church. Pray for growth as they conduct weekly Bible Studies and Sunday services.

Route 10 Community Church: Pray for **Matthew and Ruth Lahey** as they have found a permanent place for them to hold their church services. Pray for them as they work through what different ministry opportunities might look like in their community.

Rabbittown Community Church: Pray for **Kurtis and Celeste Rodgers** as they are laying the ground work for the 4th church plant in St. Johns. Rabbittown is a place full of university students, Newfoundlanders, and immigrants, and they want to bring the gospel to all of them! Pray that they will continue to make inroads into the community as they hold Bible studies and meet people through community events. Pray also that they will find a house to move into in the area and that they will be able to rent a facility so that they can start Sunday Services.
