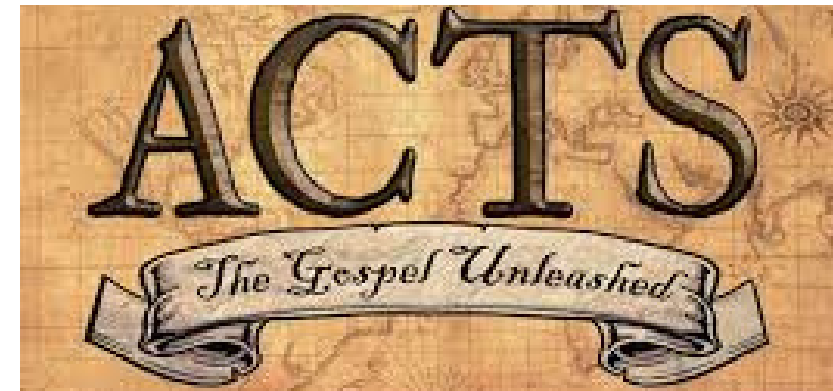

**This is an excerpt from their recent letter:** *“The unpredictable skills and availability of volunteers, sudden rain ‘down-time’, and my own physical limitations, confirm my conviction that reliance on manual labor is not the way forward. Though, the fact that pilots now landing in Trison (Feb trip) no longer need special training confirms that I’m going in the right direction. It is time to move into the next phase of the plan. I have the go-ahead to postpone airstrip repairs in order to focus on and complete the Inozer. We need more iron on the job.”*

- Praise the Lord for the work that was accomplished during Duane's recent trip.
- Pray for these translators and their work. Pray for no drama in [M] so Steve and Natalie can return to their ministry. Pray for Scott and Natasha now teaching the gospel to the [E] language group for the first time!
- Continue to pray for the tribal church planters that these landing strips are being built for. They face massive challenges, discouragements, and distractions daily and indefinitely. It is often hard for them to keep going – to finish language and culture acquisition, to translate the Bible and lessons, and to disciple churches to maturity. Pray for endurance and encouragement.
