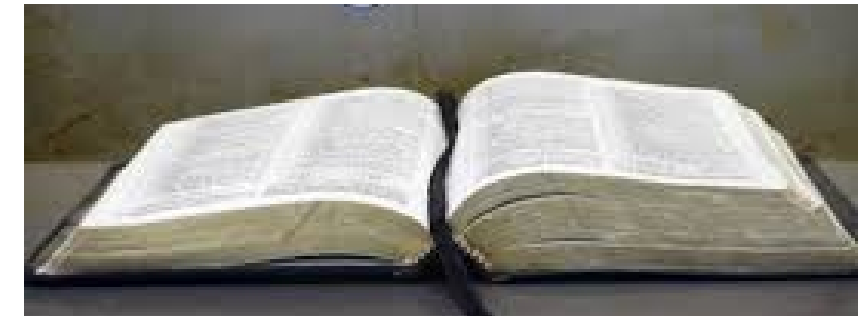

### **D’Arcy Chapman Wycliffe Bible Translators Canada**

D’Arcy Chapman is currently in the Vancouver area working remotely with an SIL team in West Africa who are doing Bible translation for groups of people who do not have the Bible in their own language. Most of the work is in Côte d’Ivoire (Ivory Coast).

### **Please Pray for these Items::**

- Pray for continued diligence and determination as work progresses in translation. Progress is often slow and tedious.
