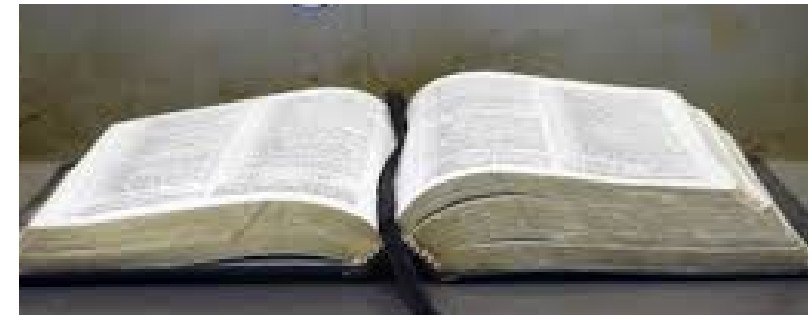

Mile One Mission - St. John’s, NFLD

Mile One Mission was founded to reach the people of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador with the gospel of Jesus Christ through the planting of churches.

Currently there are less than 1% of the population that attend any type of evangelical church. They have three church plants in St. John’s: **Downtown Community Church, Route 10 Community Church**, and the newest **Rabbittown Community Church** and one church plant in Happy Valley-Goose Bay - **Northern Cross Community Church**.

- Northern Cross Community Church:** Pray for John Lewis as he seeks to establish trust with the Indigenous communities and that he will have doors of opportunity opened for sharing the gospel. The area has a population of 9,000 - 45% are Anglo, 45% Indigenous and 10% Filipino.
- Downtown Community Church:** Pray for Adam and Sabrina Diamond as Adam shepherds this congregation. Pray for opportunities to reach into this broken community. There are approximately 10,000 people with no local evangelical church. Pray for growth as they conduct weekly Bible Studies and Sunday services.
- Route 10 Community Church:** Pray for Matthew and Ruth Lahey as they have found a permanent place for them to hold their church services. Pray for them as they work through what different ministry opportunities might look like in their community.
- Rabbittown Community Church:** Pray for Kurtis and Celeste Rodgers as they are laying the ground work for the 4th church plant in St. Johns. Robbittown is a place full of university students, Newfoundlanders, and immigrants, and they want to bring the gospel to all of them! Pray that they will continue to make inroads into the community as they hold Bible studies and meet people through community events. Praise the Lord that they have purchased a house in the area. Pray that they will be able to rent a facility so that they can start Sunday Services.
